

POSSIBLE 'NEGATIVES' TO OUR INVENTION:

1. Will there be a need for a provider and contract, as we do with mobile phone service? Obviously incurring a monthly charge is a downside. A person may feel that for the amount of use, it is not worth the monthly charge.
2. Is WIFI needed in order for the scanner or Hologram to work?
3. Can a younger child actually read, understand and maneuver the hologram?
4. Can the hologram be seen clearly in all types of lighting and in total darkness?
5. Would there be a need for two bands? (A scanner and a separate band for the Hologram)
6. Will this band be too bulky in order to have hologram capability, especially for a young child?
